

BY-LAW 93-2019

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A MEDICAL TIERED RESPONSE AGREEMENT WITH THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF LANARK TO AUTHORIZE THE OCEAN WAVE FIRE COMPANY TO RESPOND TO CERTAIN EMERGENCY CALLS TO ASSIST THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE.

WHEREAS Section 5.3 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes that municipal powers, including municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25), provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of an Agreement with the Corporation of the County of Lanark and other Fire Departments within the County to allow for the automatic dispatch of fire personnel to certain emergency calls to assist the Emergency Medical Service (EMS) in accordance with the

AND WHEREAS having one agreement will ensure consistency in response from Fire Departments across the County to medical assist calls;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carleton Place hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Town of Carleton Place a Tiered Response Agreement with the Corporation of the County of Lanark.
2. THAT the Clerk shall be and is hereby authorized to affix the corporate seal of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place to the said contract.
