Monday, March 20th also saw a spike with 2,716 users – Of that, 1027 visited the Pool page which happened to be the first test of the online swim registration system.


REPORT AN ISSUE

109 Report An Issue Forms were submitted in 2023. The majority of issues reported were typically property standards and Bylaw related with the occasional report of snow-related concerns.



SITE SEARCH

There were 441,257 searches done in 2023 using the search bar on the website.



VIRTUAL TOWN HALL

In May of 2022, the Town launched the Virtual Town Hall website which enables residents to view tax and utility accounts online, register pets or renew pet licenses, and set up pre-authorized payments.

- 858 people have signed up and created an account for their property(s).
- 555 people have either added or made a change to a pre-authorized payment method.
- 6,057 tax bills are issued twice annually, and of those, there are approximately 2,779 people (46%) who receive their billing electronically. Residents can sign up for e-billing on the Town's website or through Virtual Town Hall
- 5,404 water bills are issued quarterly, and out of those, 2,203 people (41%) receive their billing electronically. Residents can sign up for e-billing on the Town's website or through Virtual Town Hall
