

BY-LAW NO. 30-2024

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE TO AUTHORIZE THE SIGNING OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN HIS MAJESTY THE KING IN RIGHT OF ONTARIO AS REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF THE SOLICITOR GENERAL AND THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE FOR THE PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE ONTARIO PROVINCIAL POLICE.

AND WHEREAS under Section 17(2) of the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019, S.O. 2019, c. 1, Sched. 1, the Minister may enter into a written agreement with a municipality or with any other person to have the Commissioner provide policing, or other specified services that would not otherwise be provided or be required to be provided by the Commissioner;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality has expressed its desire for Ontario to provide a Community Sergeant position as an additional service by means of an Agreement;

AND WHEREAS Section 5.3 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes that municipal powers, including municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25), provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 22 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25), authorizes a municipality to provide a system that it would otherwise not have power to provide within a municipality, if it does so in accordance with an agreement with the Province of Ontario under a program established and administered by the Province of Ontario;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Carleton Place deems it expedient to enter into a five (5) year agreement with His Majesty the King in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of the Solicitor General to provide a Community Sergeant position as an additional policing service to the Town by the Ontario Provincial Police;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place enacts as follows:

1. **SHORT TITLE**

This By-Law is short titled "OPP Policing Contract Enhancement 2024-2029".

2. **AGREEMENT**

- (a) **THAT** the Mayor and CAO/Deputy Clerk shall be and are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place to enter into an agreement between the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place and His Majesty the King in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of the Solicitor General to provide additional policing services to

the Town by the Ontario Provincial Police (O.P.P.).

- (b) **THAT** the Clerk shall be and is hereby authorized to affix the corporate seal of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place to the said agreement.

READ A FIRST TIME, SECOND TIME AND A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 16TH DAY OF APRIL, 2024.
