

## **BY-LAW NO. 108-2019**

**A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE TO AUTHORIZE THE SIGNING OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF ONTARIO AS REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF THE SOLICITOR GENERAL AND THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE FOR THE PROVISION OF POLICE SERVICES.**

**AND WHEREAS** under Section 4 (1) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, the Municipality is required to provide adequate and effective police services in accordance with its needs;

**AND WHEREAS** under Section 5 of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, the Municipality's responsibility for providing police services may be discharged by entering into an Agreement with the Solicitor General under Section 10 of the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 10 (1) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, authorizes that the Solicitor General may enter into an agreement with the council of a municipality or jointly with the councils of two or more municipalities for the provision of police services for the municipality or municipalities by the Ontario Provincial Police;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 5.3 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes that municipal powers, including municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25), provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 22 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25), authorizes a municipality to provide a system that it would otherwise not have power to provide within a municipality, if it does so in accordance with an agreement with the Province of Ontario under a program established and administered by the Province of Ontario;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Carleton Place deems it expedient to enter into an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of the Solicitor General to provide policing services to the Town by the Ontario Provincial Police;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place enacts as follows:

1. **SHORT TITLE**

This By-Law is short titled "OPP Policing Contract 2020-XX".

2. **AGREEMENT**

(a) **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk shall be and are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place to enter into an agreement between the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place and

Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of the Solicitor General to provide policing services to the Town by the Ontario Provincial Police (O.P.P.).

- (b) **THAT** the Clerk shall be and is hereby authorized to affix the corporate seal of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place to the said agreement.
