## **BY-LAW NO. 26-2024**

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE TO AUTHORIZE THE SIGNING OF A CONSTRUCTION LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THOMAS CAVANAGH CONSTRUCITON LTD. AND THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE FOR USE OF TOWN OWNED LANDS ON ROE STREET.

**WHEREAS** Section 5.3 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes that municipal powers, including municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001 (S.O. 2001, c.25), provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Carleton Place deems it expedient to enter into a construction license agreement with Thomas Cavanagh Construction Ltd. to allow the use of the Town's lands described as Part Lot 16, Concession 11, Beckwith, being Parts 3 and 8, 27R11243; S/T Easement over Part 3, 27R11243 as in LC196971; S/T and easement in gross over Part 8, 27R11346 as in LC206698; Town of Carleton Place on the condition that the Town's legal costs of preparing the agreement are covered;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place enacts as follows:

## 1. SHORT TITLE

This By-Law is short titled "Construction License Agreement - Cavanagh".

## 2. **AGREEMENT**

- (a) **THAT** the Mayor and CAO/Deputy Clerk shall be and are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place to enter into a construction license agreement between the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place and Thomas Cavanagh Construction Ltd..
- (b) THAT the Clerk shall be and is hereby authorized to affix the corporate seal of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place to the said agreement.
